## Adriaan's top 10 reads of the day

Health Minister Aaron **Motsoaledi says there will be no changes to the part of the NHI Act that says medical aids in their current form will be scrapped**, as they won't be allowed to cover the same services as the NHI. He told Bhekisisa that he wouldn't budge, even if it means the end of the government of national unity.

An IT outage that downed FNB systems, including its app and website from 12:25 on Friday, was seemingly mostly resolved later in the afternoon. Banking customers took to social media to **complain about not being able to access the FNB app and not being able to process payday payments**.
